Thank you for choosing to book Beacon View Barn. We look forward to welcoming you. By making this booking you are entering an agreement with us. Please read our terms and conditions of booking below.

Prices

The price of the accommodation includes the following: electricity, wifi, hot water, central heating, logs, Gas BBQ, towels and cotton bed linen but please bring your own cot linen.

When you submit a booking via our online reservation system you will receive an automatically generated booking summary by email to the email address you provide in the booking form. This does not form a contract between us. A contract shall only arise when your booking is subsequently confirmed in writing via a letter of confirmation sent to you by post or email.

Pets

We accept one well behaved dog.

Acceptance of Children

We welcome children of all ages.

We do not accept single gender parties (hen and stag parties)

Beacon View Barn is strictly non smoking

Without prior agreement our facilities indoors and outside are for the use of the 6 people booked into the barn.

Cancellation and Insurance

By making your booking, our agreement is a legal contract and your deposit is non-refundable. If you cannot take your holiday and the booking cannot be re-let, you are still liable to pay for the booking in full, even if we have not yet received your balance. A non refundable £300 deposit secures your booking, the balance is due 60 days before the start of your holiday.

CANCELLATION or CHANGE OF BOOKING

We must be immediately notified by phone and confirmation in writing. If we are able to re-let your booking we will refund you the final letting price (which may be less than you paid) less an administration fee of £40.00.

Please note that your deposit is not refundable under any circumstances. We would highly recommend that you take out holiday and cancellation insurance to cover this cost.

Non-availability of Accommodation

We would only cancel your holiday if your accommodation was unavailable for reasons beyond our control. We would however attempt to offer you alternative accommodation. If this was not possible, or unacceptable to you, then we would refund all monies paid by you for the holiday. Our liability would not extend beyond this refund.

Arrival

Your accommodation will be available to you from 4.00 pm on the day of arrival, unless otherwise arranged. We may not be able to accommodate you if you arrive earlier than the agreed time as we will be busy preparing the barn for you.

Late arrival procedure

Please let us know if you will be arriving late, so that we can be sure to welcome you in and show you around.

Departure

Please be ready to leave the accommodation by 10.00 am on the day of departure, unless otherwise arranged

Damages and Breakages

Please take care when staying in our property. You are responsible and liable for any breakages or damages, which you cause, to the accommodation or its contents. All we ask is that you report any incidents as they occur. We do not normally charge for minor breakages, but we may send you an invoice for repair or making good if the damage or breakage is significant, and we may make an additional charge of £50 if you did not report this.

Liability

We do not accept any liability for any damage, loss or injury to any member of your party or any vehicles or possessions, unless proven to be caused by a negligent act by ourselves or our employees or contractors whilst acting in the course of employment.□
